When did you attend Lowanna College?

As I write this I am just about to head to the States to teach music to kids at a summer camp in California, which I am super excited about!

What are your greatest accomplishments (list any awards, achievements, defining moments etc.)?

One of my greatest accomplishments was winning the 2014 'FreezA Push Start Battle of the Bands' competition. I performed as a solo artist and became the first ever soloist to win the competition, competing against 350 bands from Victoria. It was an incredible day and felt like a lot of hard work had paid off. Another one of my favourite moments was playing at the Bluebird Cafe in Nashville, Tennesse in 2016. The Bluebird is a renowned singer songwriter venue and it was an unreal honour to play on the same stage that some of my favourite artists had also performed on.

What advice would you like to give any of our current Lowanna College students?

- Don't stress too much if you don't yet know exactly what it is you want to do after school. Definitely stick it out and finish Year 12 because having that behind you is invaluable and will really help afterwards!
- It's okay if you feel a little lost at the moment, you will find your calling even if it takes a little time.
